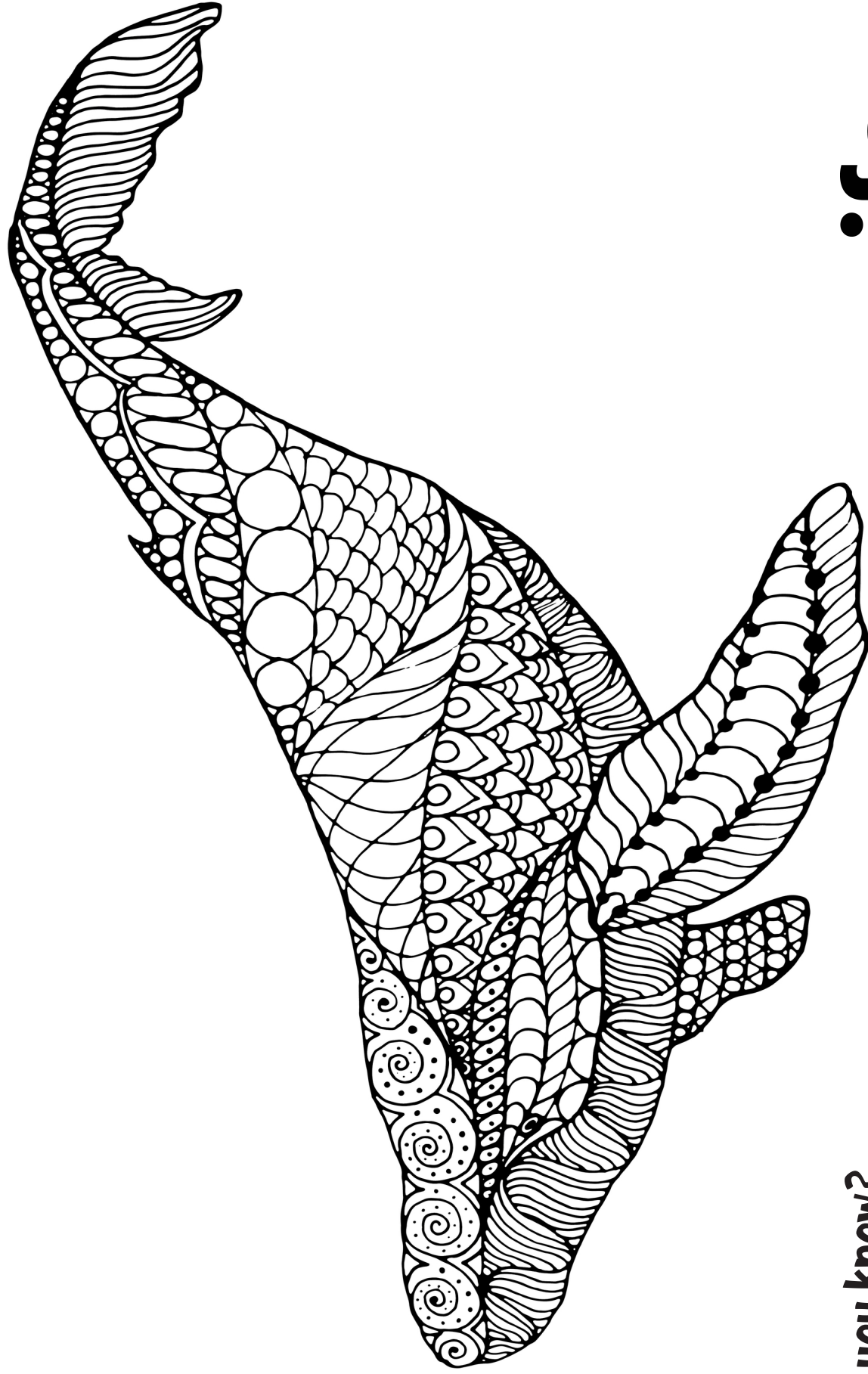


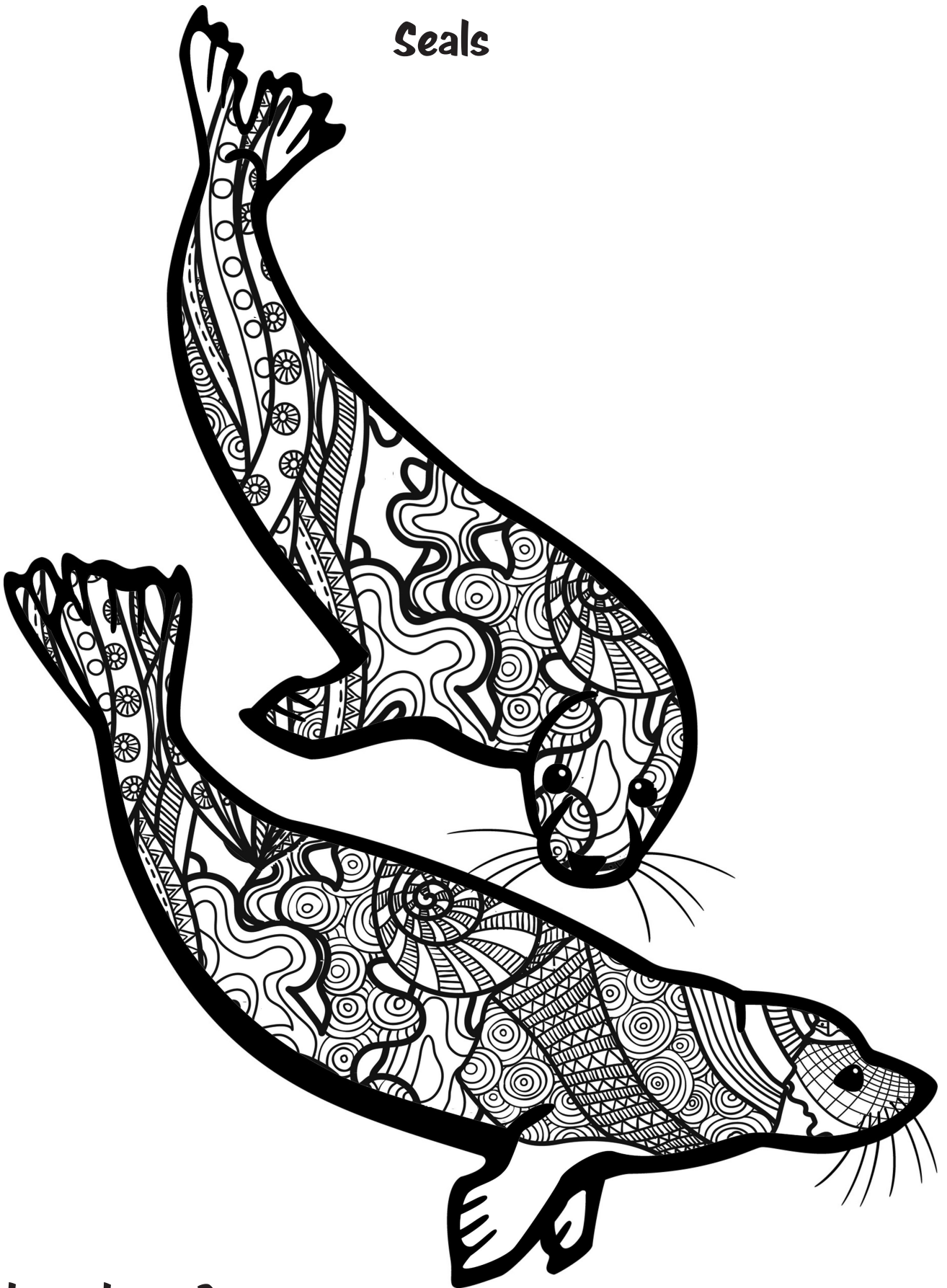
Whale

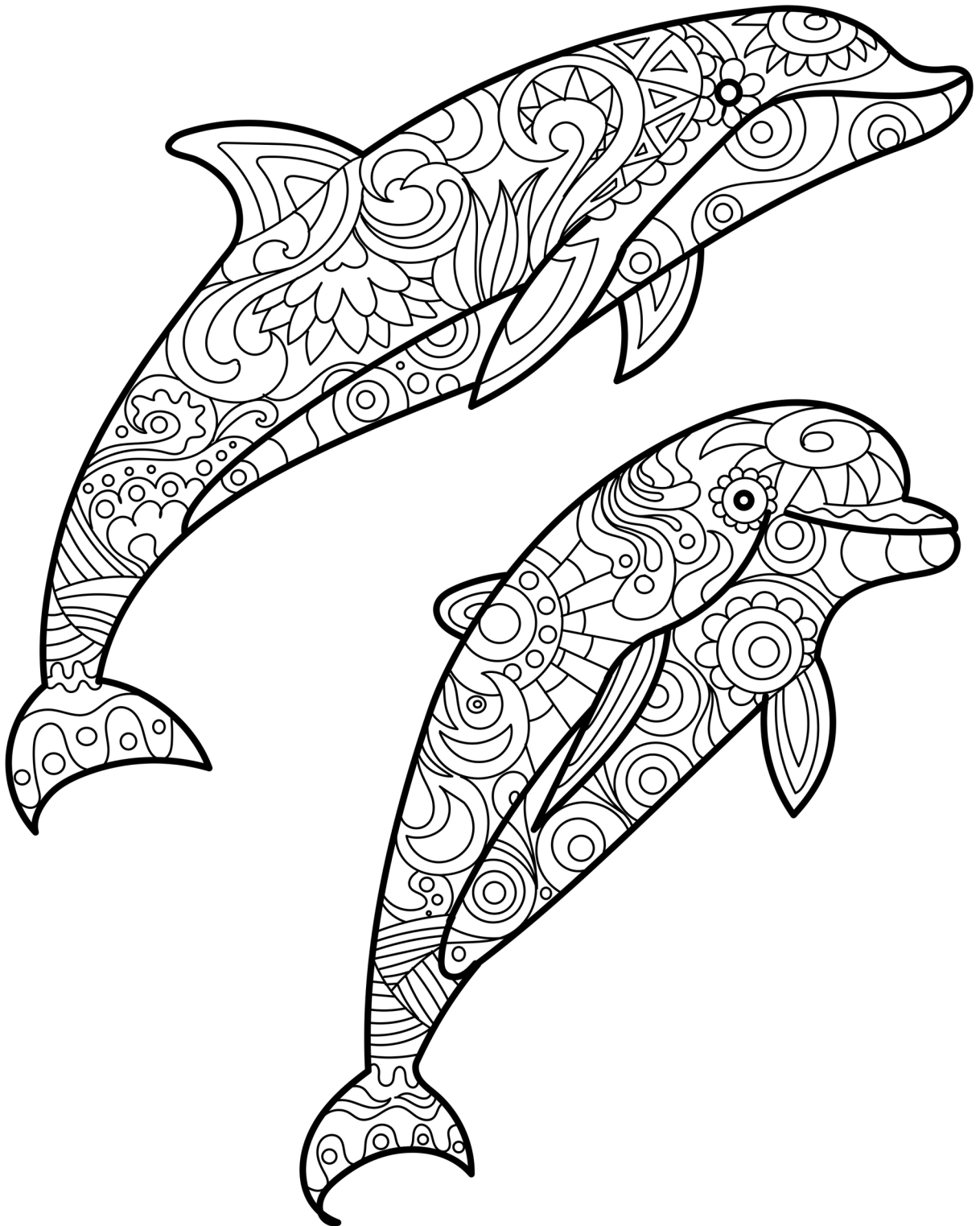


Did you know?

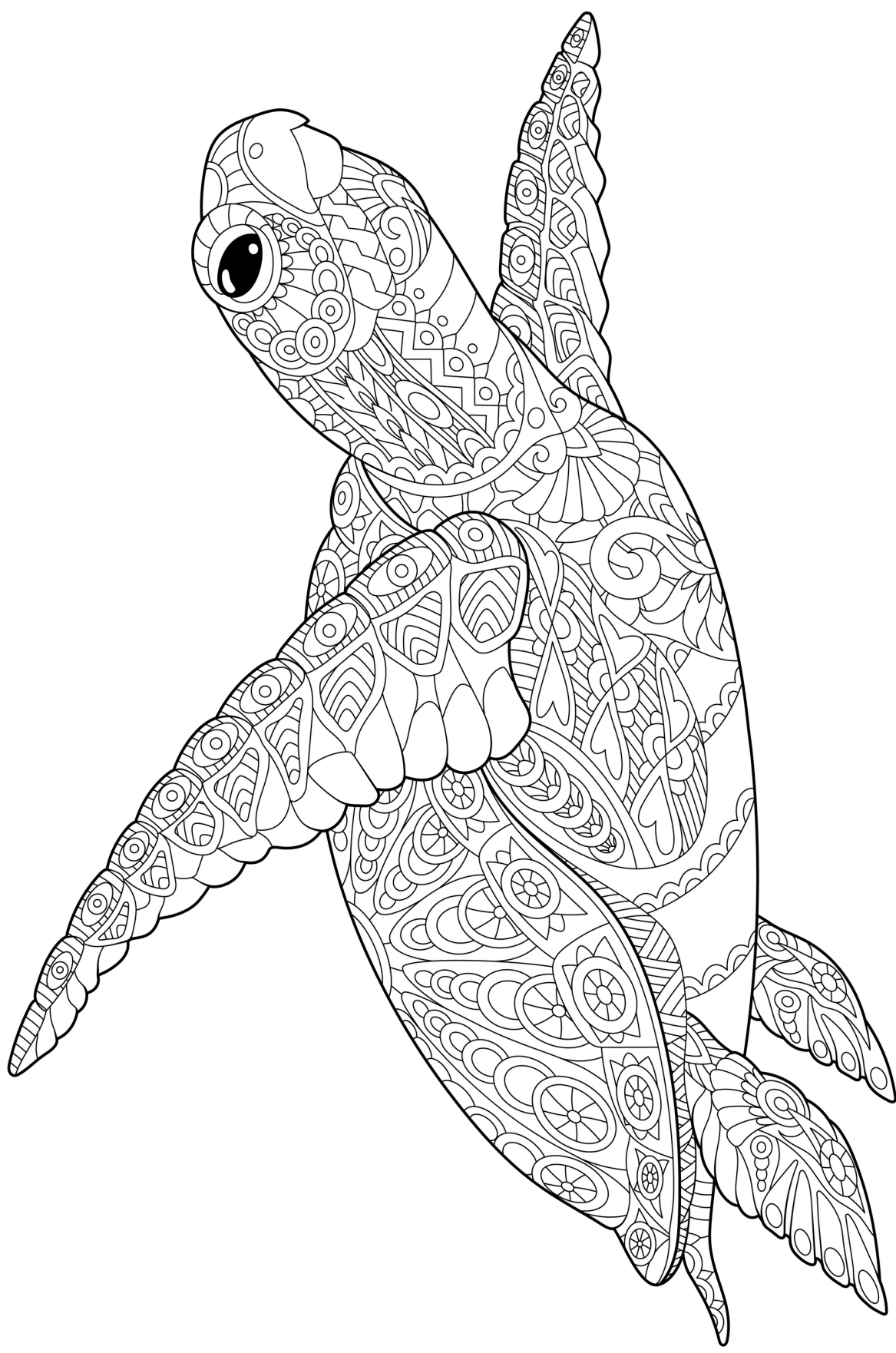
Dolphins

Dolphins use a blowhole on the top of their heads to breathe.

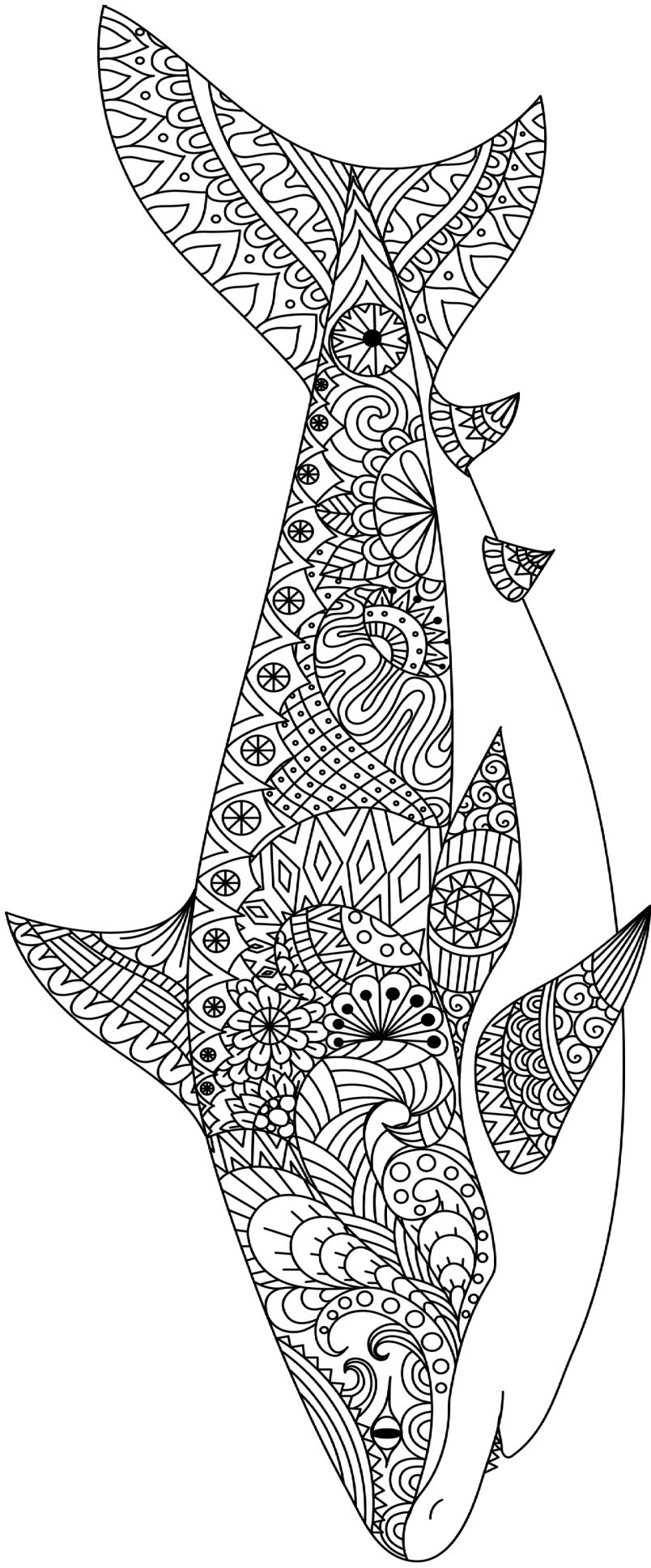
Sea Turtle

Unlike land turtles, sea turtles can't hide their head and legs inside their shell.

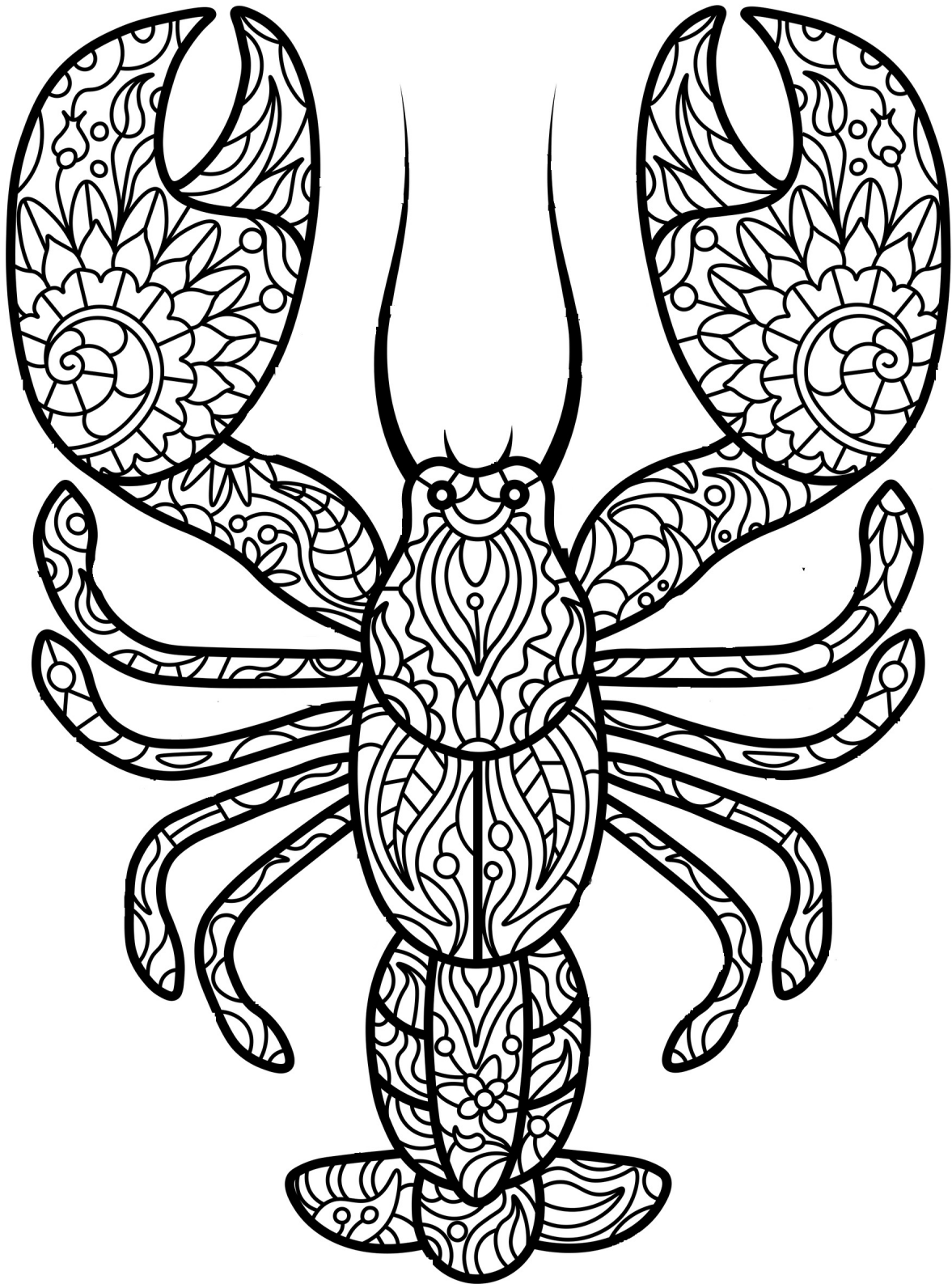
Shark

A shark may grow and use 20,000 teeth during its lifetime.

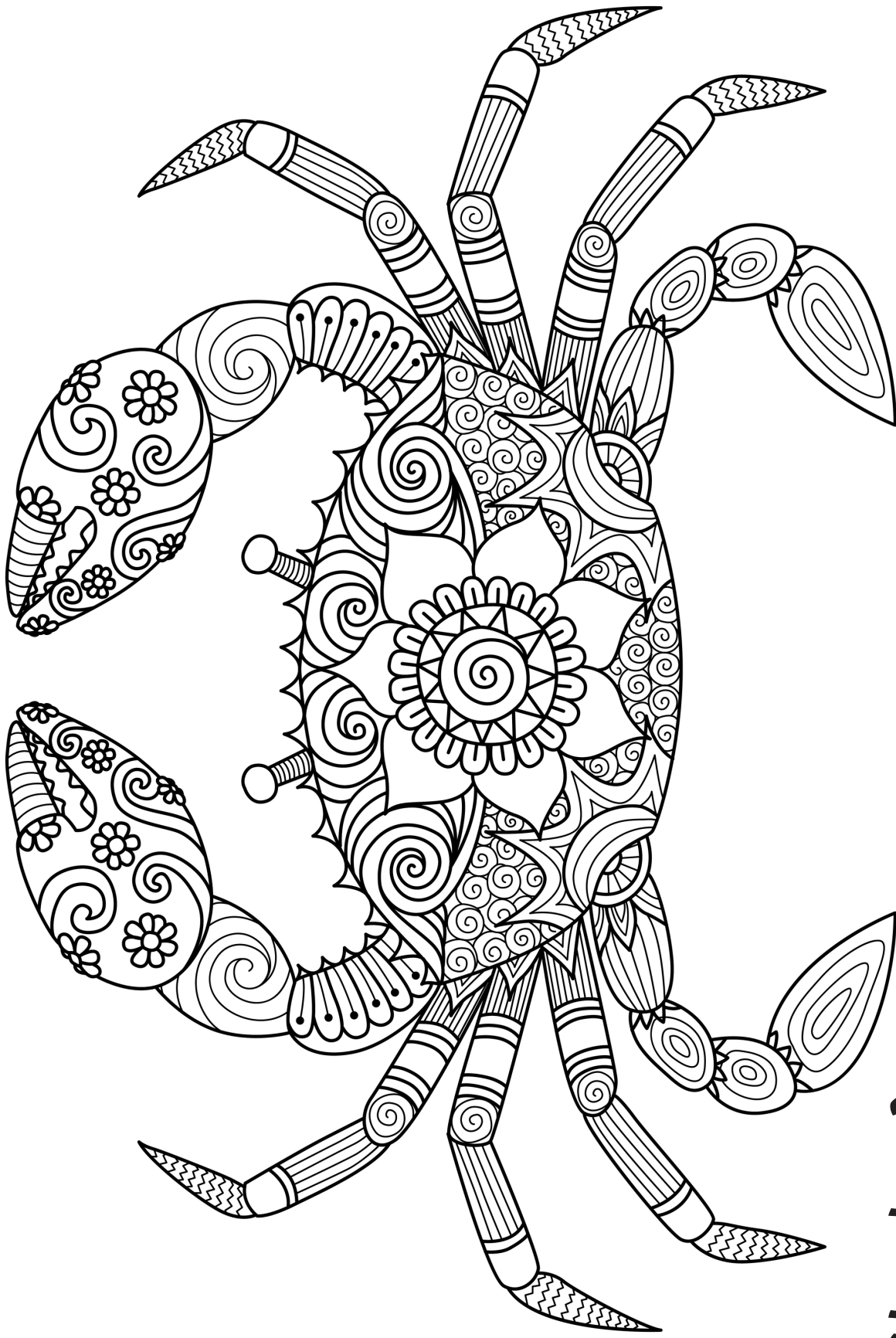
Lobster

Some lobsters may live as long as 100 years.

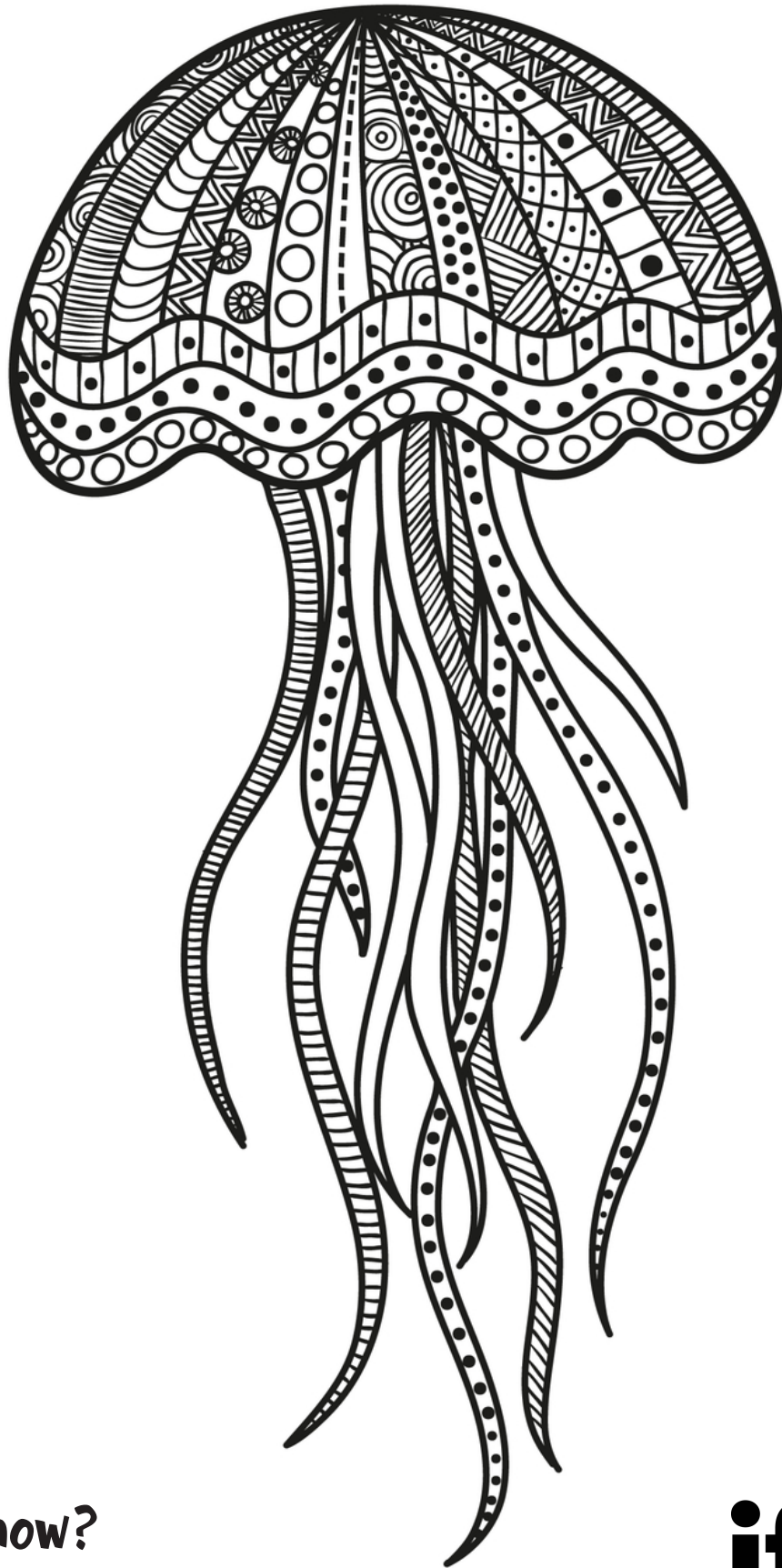
Crab

Some kinds of crabs naturally shed their claws, which then grow back in about a year.

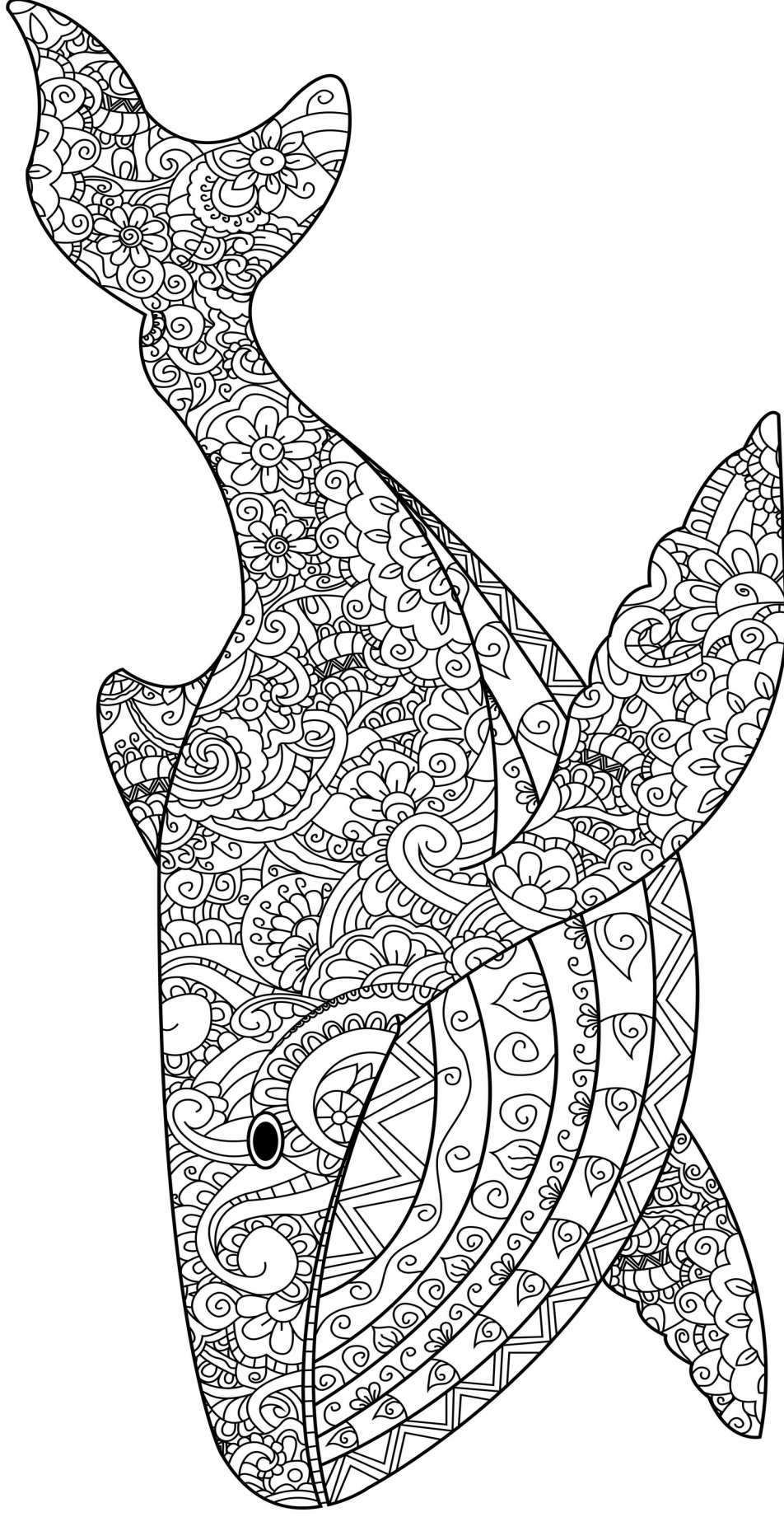
Jellyfish
