IFAW has developed this 5-step checklist as an animal evacuation contingency plan tool in the event a case worker(s) is sick with COVID-19, exposed to SARS-CoV-2 or the work capacity decreases due to government working and social distancing restrictions and animals in care need to be relocated or evacuated to other carers and care facilities.
